

## **Bulimba Golf Club Announcement (COVID-19)**

As the Covid-19 pandemic is impacting almost all elements of our daily life, the Committee would like to inform you that taking steps to ensure the health and welfare of our members, clients, staff and volunteers is of paramount importance to them.

Measures, procedures and protections to minimise the possibility of infection spreading throughout our community have been put in place.

### **TRAVEL ADVICE**

Currently there are no known cases of COVID-19 at the Club however we advise our members and guests that if you are experiencing flu-like symptoms or have recently returned from overseas to wait 14 days before visiting the Club.

### **CLUBHOUSE**

- The golf course, bar, restaurant and gaming area remain open as normal
- We will monitor and limit capacity to ensure there are no more than 25 people in a 100m<sup>2</sup> indoor area
- Social distancing – Our tables and chairs have been spread out across the outdoor areas and Clubhouse. Please do not move furniture without asking the staff.
- Encouraging customers to use "Pay Wave"
- Water stations on the bar will cease for the time being however you can request a glass over the bar
- Hand sanitiser is readily available for guests at the reception and golf window before entering the Clubhouse
- Disinfecting frequently touched areas regularly including:
  - Door handles
  - Bar surfaces
  - Members competition computer
  - Tables and chairs
  - ATM
  - Gaming machines

### **FUNCTIONS & EVENTS**

- Peter Cupples show for Saturday 28 March has been postponed
- Our annual Pig Racing Day scheduled for Sunday 29 March has been postponed. We will keep you informed of the new date.

- Easter Sunday has not been cancelled as yet and we will make a call closer to the date.
- Bohemian Rhapsody Queen Tribute scheduled for Friday 1 May has not been postponed yet, pending the government restrictions on events
- Sunday sessions & Friday evenings – The bar and restaurant will be operating as normal however for hygiene reasons, the jumping castle will not be operating. The live music will be cancelled for the next few weeks.

## **GOLF**

- Wear gloves if possible
- Flag sticks are to be left in holes at all times
- Rakes have been removed from bunkers. Please repair the sand as best you can
- Keep 1.5m apart at all times
- Playing in groups of four will be strongly enforced
- Hand sanitiser is available at the golf window
- Effective from Wednesday 1 April, competition fees cannot be paid for using cash

## **STAFF, MEMBERS & GUESTS**

It is extremely important that if a member, guest or staff member tests positive to COVID-19, they are to inform the Club as soon as possible.

All staff have been reminded of standard hygiene practices including:

- Cough and sneeze etiquette (covering your face, using a tissue and washing hands afterwards)
- Washing hands regularly, particularly after clearing plates and glasses or handling cash
- Staying home if they are feeling unwell

If a member, guest or staff member does test positive for COVID-19 and has been to the Club since having the virus, the following steps must be taken:

- Inform the office immediately
- Do not visit the Club under any circumstances
- Provide a list of people they came into contact with at the Club
