1. INTRODUCTION (CONSTITUTION: S12).

1.1 Section 12 of The Club's Constitution enables the QSC Management Committee to make and administer Bylaws. These Bylaws are in effect the rules and policies as reviewed and amended over time, to deal with the day to day management and operations of The Queensland Sporting Club Incorporated.

1.2 These Bylaws as amended must at all times remain consistent with the Constitution.

1.3 Cross referencing of each Section in the Bylaws to the appropriate Sections of the Constitution is undertaken to ensure Members understand the Constitutional basis on which Bylaws are made and amended over time. Included in each Bylaws Section and as elsewhere necessary in the Sub-Sections of the Bylaws, is an abbreviated reference to the relevant part/s of the Constitution.

For example, in each Section Heading see bold text: "1. **INTRODUCTION (C: S12).**" There are other similar references to the Constitution throughout the Bylaws which appear in normal text.

1.4 Any Bylaws or amendments to same made by the Board under their authority in the Constitution, once properly notified are binding on all members of the Club.

1.5 These Bylaws are available on the Club's Website. Any Ordinary Member will be supplied with a printed copy of same if required.

2. DEFINITIONS AND INTERPRETATION (C: S2.1 and 2.2).

2.1 Definitions of words and terms set out in these Bylaws have the same meaning as in they appear in the Constitution. For any other word or term in these Bylaws, the ordinary dictionary meaning of words applies.

2.2 The rules concerning interpretation set down in the Constitution must be applied at all times when interpreting these Bylaws.

3. INTRODUCTORY PROVISIONS (C: S1.2)

3.1 The name of the incorporated association is The Queensland Sporting Club Incorporated - trading as Bulimba Golf Club.

4. MEMBERSHIP (C: S3.1.1.a.iv)

4.1 Sub-classes of ordinary membership consist of the following:

7-Day Full Membership (Monday - Sunday) - This allows members to play every day that the course is open

5-Day Weekday Membership (Monday - Friday) - This allows members to play any weekday that the course is open

2-Day Weekend Membership (Saturday & Sunday only) - This allows members to play each day of the weekend that the course is open.

Members may play on days outside of their specified membership but must pay additional green fees.

Note: The course may be closed for special events throughout the year and the members will not be entitled to a reduction in fees or other special entitlements.

5. THE MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE, SUBCOMMITTEES AND DELEGATION (C: S5.1.1.)

5.1 The Management Committee of the association must have a minimum of three members and up to a maximum of 5 members. The minimum of three members must consist of a President, a Treasurer and one other member. The maximum of five members must consist of a President, a Treasurer and three other Committee Members.
